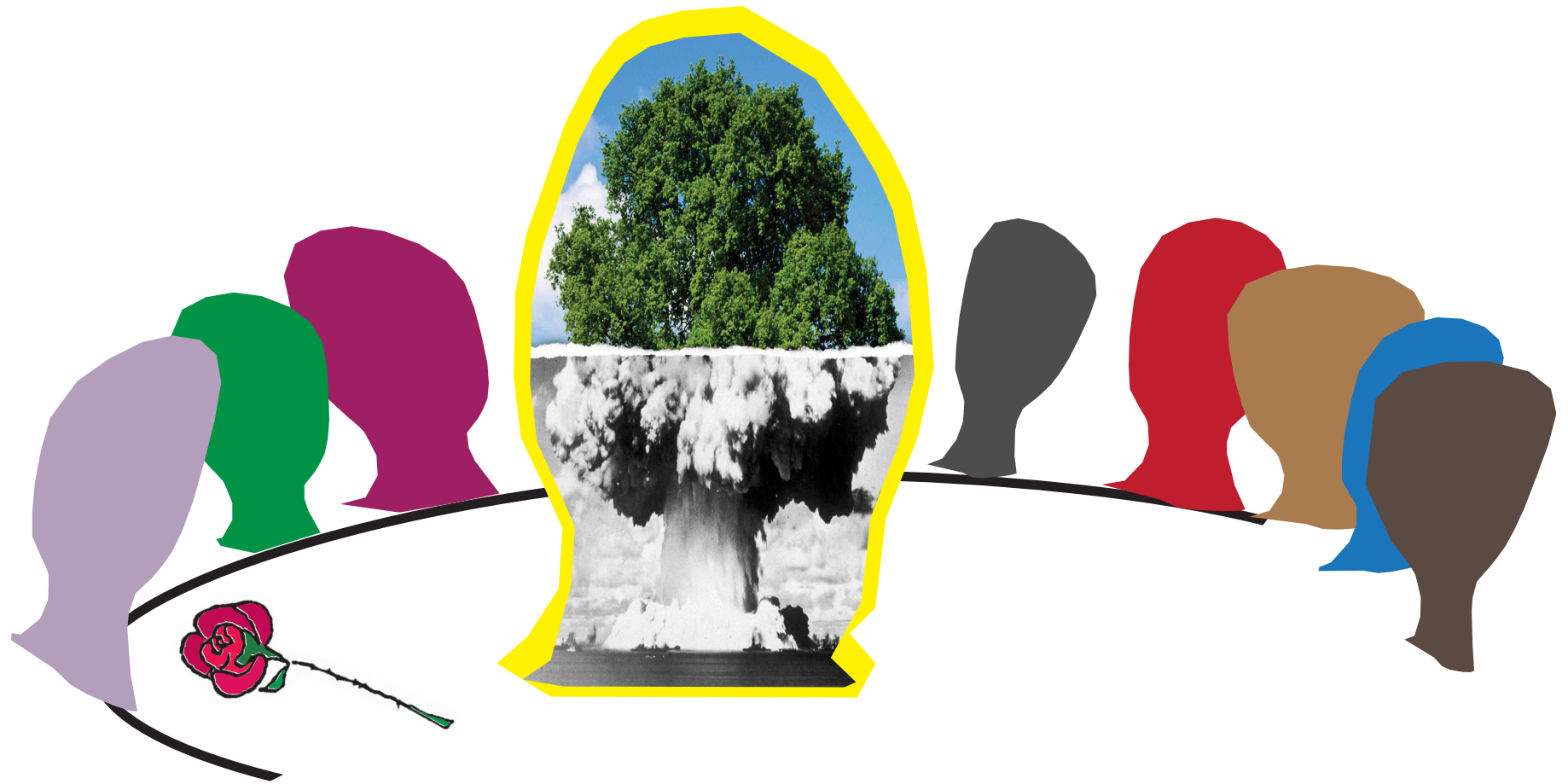


For a Nuclear Free, Peaceful, Just and Sustainable World
